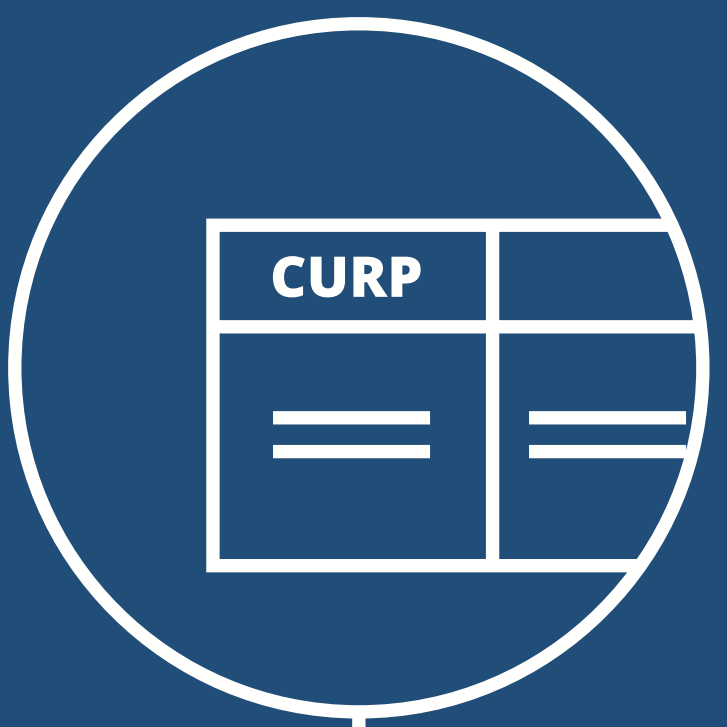


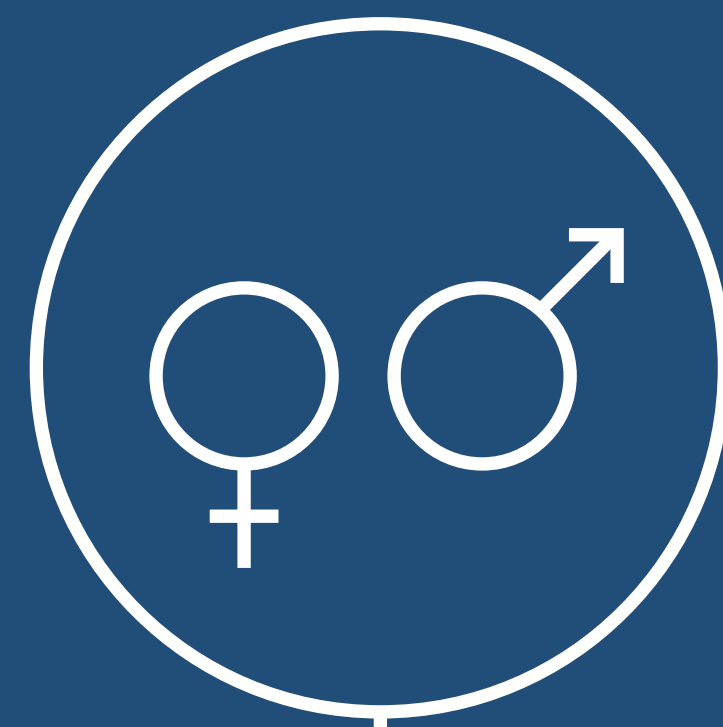
HOW CAN I OBTAIN MY BIRTH CERTIFICATE ABROAD?

If you are Mexican and you **already have a birth certificate in Mexico**, you can request it in the Mexican Consulate or online at: [LINK](#)

You will need the following **information**:



Clave Única de Registro de Población (**CURP**, Population Register Code)



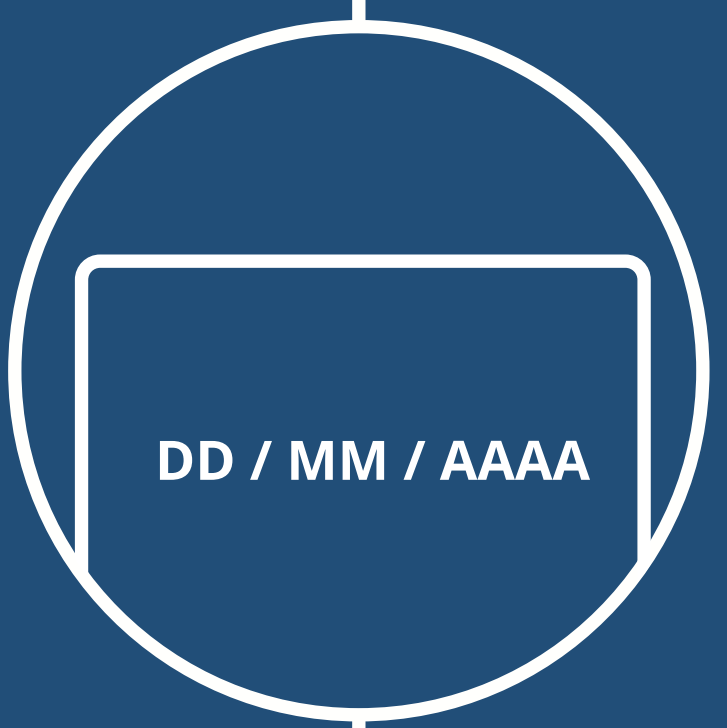
Gender



Full name



Name of your father and mother



Birthdate



If you pay online, you will need a credit or debit card



Registration entity



If you rather go to the bank, you will need to print a format

If you are **Mexican** but you have never had a Mexican birth certificate, you can request your certificate for free in the Mexican consular offices and embassies abroad. It is free of charge, however, a certified copy will cost you **\$13 dollars**.

You will need:



Visit the office with the person who will request the certificate. Minors must show up with their parents, mother, father, guardian or the person exercising parental authority



Your parents, father or mother must prove his/her/their identity



You need to take with you a birth certificate issued by a hospital or the clinic where the person was born or, if applicable, by the midwife who delivered the baby



Two witnesses over 18 years and their official IDs



Your parents, father or mother must prove he/she/they is/are Mexican citizen(s)



You will need an updated document to prove your current place of residence
