

# IF I GO BACK TO MEXICO, HOW CAN I TAKE MY BELONGINGS WITH ME?






If you have been abroad for **more than six months** and you go back to Mexico, you can process a “Certificado a lista de menaje de casa” (a certificate with which you can list the furniture and household you want to take back to Mexico) in order to enter the country with your belongings **TAX FREE**.

This document can be requested at the consulate and it costs **\$95 USD**. If you are repatriated, it is **for free**.

What you can take back to Mexico includes: furniture, books, clothing, jewelry and tools or things that are essential for your occupation.

What is the limit amount allowed?

The following items can be **imported**:

	Used household appliances	Do not pay taxes
	Miscellaneous articles	\$1000 USD per family member
	Tools	\$5000 USD
	Cash, checks or documents receivable	Up to \$ 10,000 tax free. If you exceed that amount, you must declare it at customs
	Vehicle	It must be used for no longer than 10 years and meet the import and payment requirements

For this process, we suggest you to ask a customs officer directly.

**Documentation** necessary to complete the procedure:



A document to prove your nationality (original and copy)



A list of the furniture and household utensils with autograph signature (4 original documents)



Official identification with photograph (original)



Pay at the consular office and keep/present the original ticket



A document that proves you residency abroad (original and copy)



In case of being deported, present the official document of departure from the USA (original and copy)
