
WHAT SHOULD I DO IN CASE I HAVE TO RETURN TO MEXICO?

If your **immigration status represents a risk** and you think you have a large possibility of returning to Mexico, we suggest you do the following:



- 1. Register your sons and daughters as Mexican citizens in the Mexican consulate by processing their birth certificates and/or passports
- 2. In case you need it, also process your **Mexican passport.** If possible, process the **American passport**
- 3. Obtain certified copies of your family's birth certificates
- 4. Obtain a valid ID
- 5. If possible, process your social security number
- 6. Obtain the **school transfer request document** at the consulate (for elementary and middle school, that is, up to ninth grade in the US educational system)
- 7. Request your "Certificado a lista de menaje de casa" at the consulate (a certificate with which you can list the furniture and household you want to take back to Mexico)
- 8. Solve any legal process in which you might be involved

If possible, scan your most important documents and save them in a USB, email or cloud. Otherwise, you can also take photographs of these documents and store them in a secure place. They will not have full official validity, but they can be useful.
