

WHAT SHOULD I DO IF I AM DETAINED BY ICE?

If you are detained by an ICE agent, your relatives can go to ICE's website to find information about adults held in custody. ICE must provide them with a foreign registration number that will enable your location:

This will help your family find you.



* You have the right to an attorney. It is not the government's responsibility to provide one. If you do not have a lawyer, you can request a list of legal advisory professionals who offer low-cost or free legal services



* You have the right to get in touch with the consulate or have an officer notify the consulate of your arrest



* You have the right to remain silent. Do not talk about your migratory status with anyone but your attorney. Tell the immigration agent that you wish to remain silent



* Do not sign any document, or your voluntary departure, or anything you do not fully understand without talking to your attorney first. If you sign, you might be giving up the opportunity to try and stay in the US



* Make sure someone you trust has copy of all your immigration documents
