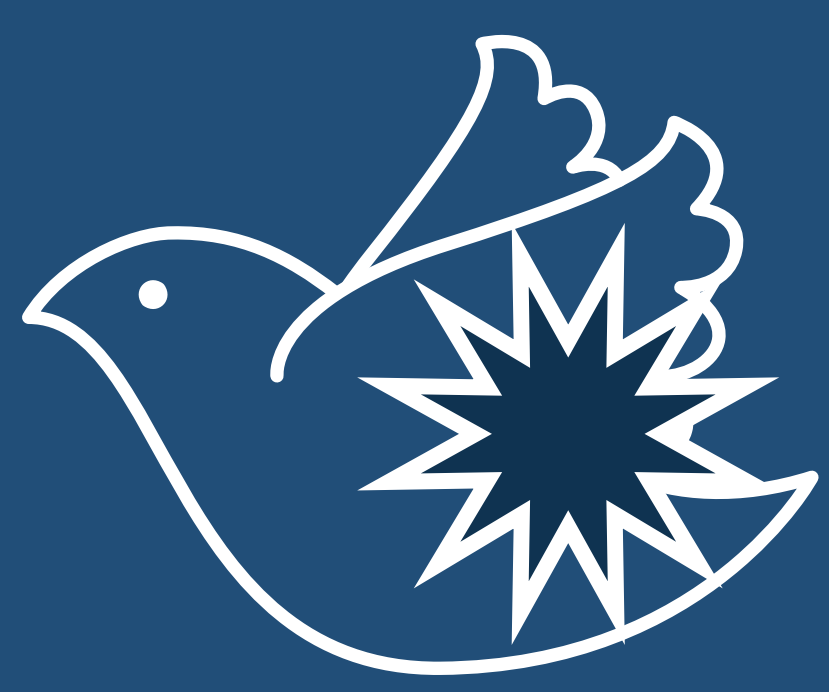


WHAT TYPES OF PROBLEMS CAN THE CONSULATE ASSIST ME WITH?

The consulate can help you!

You can go to the consulate in case you have a problem or concern related to:



Violation of your human rights



Your migratory situation:

- Detention by migratory authorities
- Repatriation of persons in vulnerable situations
- Humanitarian parole



Criminal issues:

- The consulate offers guidance in case of being detained by authorities
- Legal aid in cases of death penalty
- Economic resources delivery to incarcerated people
- Transfer of convicts to Mexican prisons



Administrative matters:

- Search of fellow nationals
- Presumption of nationality
- Recovery of a fellow national's belongings
- Identification of the remains of a fellow national
- Transfer of human remains
- Patients repatriation



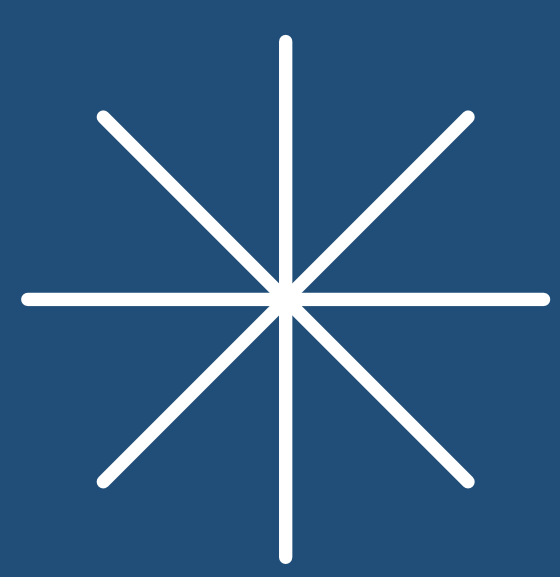
Labor issues:

- Guidance in case of occupational injuries
- Guidance in case of unpaid salary



Civil matters:

- Minors in custody of foreign authorities
- Guidance on civil lawsuits
- Request of child support
- Rightful return of the minor



Topics of particular interest:

- Guidance and assistance in cases of domestic violence
- Guidance and assistance for victims of human trafficking
