

WHERE CAN I GO IF I REQUIRE FINANCIAL AID?

The **General Directorate for the Protection of Mexicans Abroad** (*Dirección General de Protección a Mexicanos en el Exterior*) offers different support programs that can **help you cover your expenses** (food, transportation, medicines, among others) for a limited period of time. If you are interested in acquiring any of these aids, you can go to the consulate to request it.

What do I need to **enroll in DGMPE's** programs?

Bear in mind that, in order to receive the benefits of these programs, you must have the following documents at hand:

A **document** that proves your **nationality**:

Statement of Mexican Nationality

Certificate of Mexican nationality



Passport



Military Service Card



Naturalization certificate

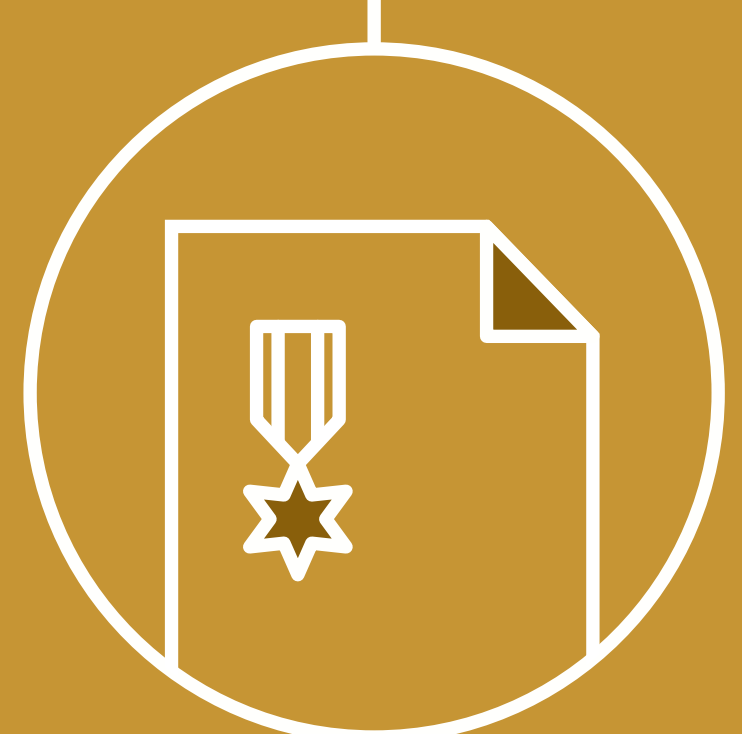

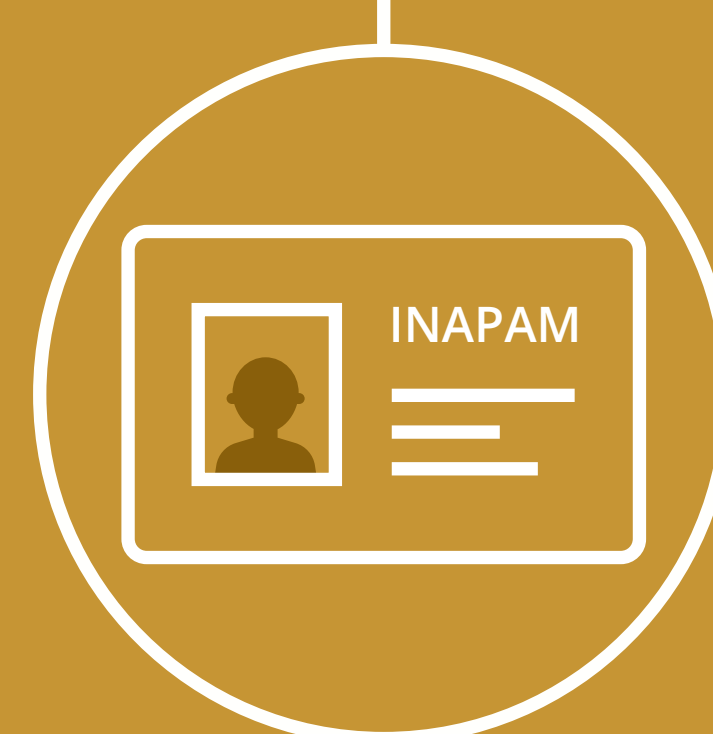
