
IF I GO BACK TO MEXICO, WHAT HAPPENS TO MY DEBT?

Attention! When you leave the US, your debts are not cancelled. The person or institution that lent you money can collect the debt, even if you are already in Mexico. This can affect your credit history when trying to get credits or

other financial services in this country.


What happens if I get deported?



Keep record of your creditor's information and send your payment as soon as you get to your new place of residence in Mexico



Get in touch with the lender after having being deported to give him/her your updated postal address



It is advisable for a friend or relative to keep a list with the address and phone number of the companies you have credit cards with to inform them of your situation
