The program for identifying the remains of fellow nationals offers support to the relatives of Mexican people who passed away in the U.S. Through this program, the consulate helps you with the following processes:



Analysis of the genetic material of the deceased



Sample collation to confirm identity



Comparison of genetic material



Repatriation of remains

What do I need to do in order to receive this support?

The person who passed away must have been Mexican. The relatives must be willing to pay for the expenses that are not covered by the program. For more information, visit your nearest consulate.
