IN CASE I GET ARRESTED, HOW CAN MY FAMILY MEMBERS FIND ME?



Once you are detained, request to make a telephone call to your emergency contact (family or friend) and the consulate and provide them with the following information: Immigrant registration number assigned (A-Number), the name of the deportation officer, the name and location of the facility where you were arrested

Immediately request to contact the Mexican consulate, it is your right and it is very important that your consulate is informed about your detention. The number of the **Information and Assistance Center for Mexicans** from the United States is **18554636395** and from Mexico **0015206237874**. It works 24 hours a day

Make sure your relatives have contact with the Mexican consulate

Make sure your family members know the website where you can locate persons detained by ICE or the telephone number of the Enforcement and Removal Operations Field Offices of ICE 202-305-2734. For this, they must have your full name and the immigrant registration number you were given (A-Number). The link to access ICE website is: LINK
