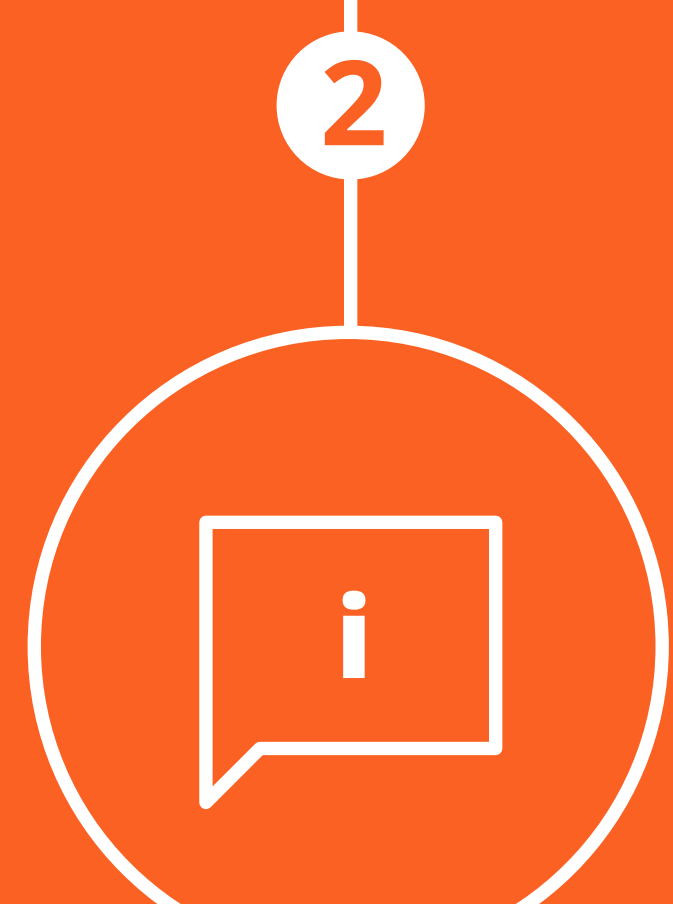


IF YOUR CHILDREN ARE WITH YOU AT THE TIME OF DETENTION:



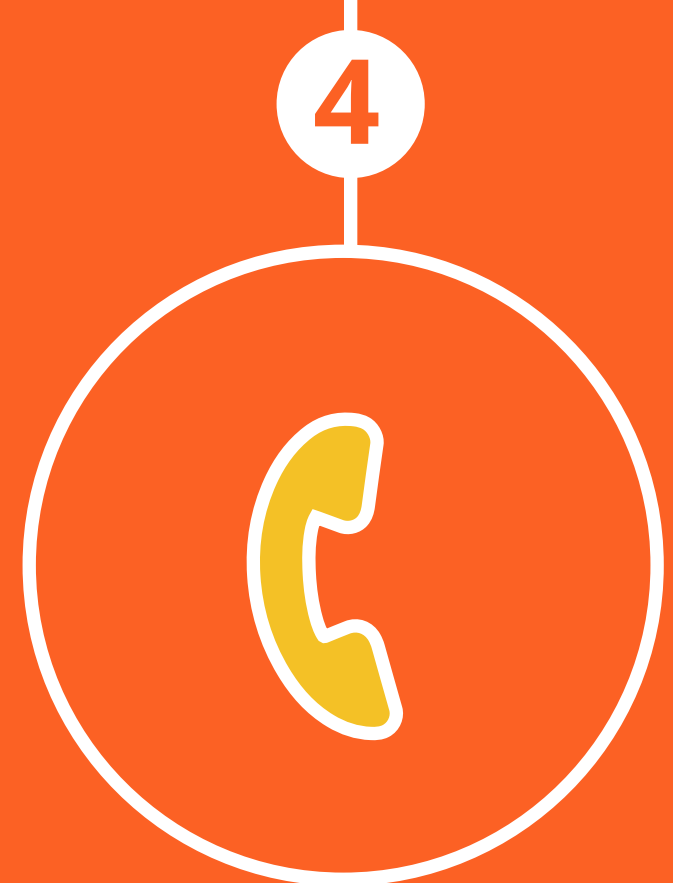
1 Immediately request to make a phone call so that a caregiver or someone you trust can pick up the children before they are taken into custody by a child welfare agency



2 You must inform the appointed caregiver that you have been detained by ICE and that you must follow the emergency plans agreed beforehand or follow the instructions that you decide in that moment



3 If you are denied to make a phone call, you should insist and explain that you are responsible for your children, so it is urgent for you to make some arrangements regarding their care before they are placed in the custody of a child welfare agency



4 It is your right to be able to communicate with your consulate to get help, so request to get in touch immediately with the Mexican authorities.
