

IF YOU SHARE THE CUSTODY OF YOUR CHILD WITH ANOTHER PERSON (FATHER OR MOTHER) AND YOU WANT TO TAKE YOUR CHILD WITH YOU ONCE YOU GET DEPORTED:



The possibility of taking your child with you depends on whether you can obtain permission from the other natural guardian (father or mother) or from the court. If the other guardian (father or mother) accepts that the minor can travel to Mexico with the father or mother who will be deported, they must establish an agreement in writing in front of a notary public signed by both parents. The father or mother who leaves the United States must carry this document with him/her



If the other guardian (father or mother) does not want the child to go to Mexico, the father or mother who is in the process of being deported will need a court order that allows the child to leave the country. In that case, contact your consulate and a family law lawyer to get their support
