

HOW CAN I REQUEST THE CUSTODY MODIFICATION OF MY CHILDREN SO THEY CAN STAY IN THE UNITED STATES ONCE I HAVE BEEN DEPORTED?



If you want to request the custody modification of your children after being deported you will need to go through a process in the United States judicial system. It is important to take into account that each state has a specific procedure to request a court to appoint a legal guardian for a minor



If both parents are outside the United States, you must request for someone in the United States to be appointed guardian. Keep in mind that even if you are not physically there, you can request it; however, both parents will need to give their consent



If one of the natural guardians (father or mother) is in the United States, you can agree to give him or her your children custody from Mexico. In order to do this, the father or mother who remains in the United States must file a modification request before the family court in the United States so that you can give your consent from Mexico
